Christine Hooper (b. 1974 GB/FR)



Theatre director Christine Hooper visited Raumars during January and February. She worked with The Relationship Between Language and Identity –drama, which concentrated on man’s verbal relationships in different European countries. Hooper worked together with Freinet–school of Rauma. She and the 4th and 5th classes from the school prepared a theatre play, which was shown to public 25.2.2005. These workshops were actualized with Freinet–school of Rauma, Word Art Group from Pori Art Museum and with youth actors of the Evening Theatre of Rauma.
